Implemented activities

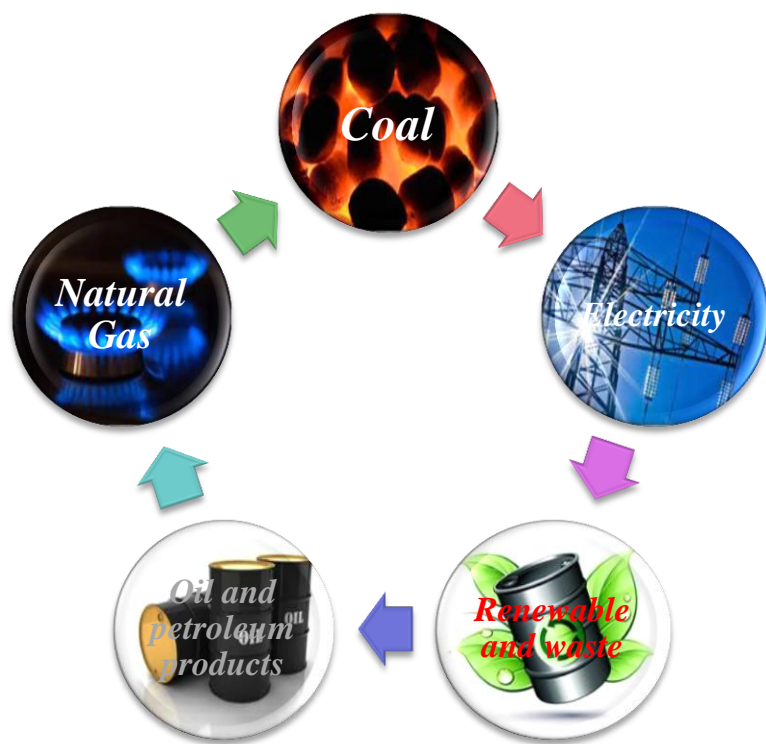
- 1st ITS Technical Assistance Mission and Workshop for GEOSTAT and MOE on the identification of stakeholders and data items needed for energy balance compilation (March, 2013);
- Include survey on energy consumption in annual state statistical work program;
- Include costs for conducting survey on energy consumption in GEOSTAT's budget;
- Enlarge number of statisticians, working on energy statistics issues;
- Participate and attend trainings, workshops, study tours and share experience of various countries;
- Conduct preparatory work for surveys (survey design, sampling frame, methodology, questionnaires, web-based (PHP) application etc)
- Field work activities and data collection
- Revision of survey results and compilation of energy balance with ITS assistance

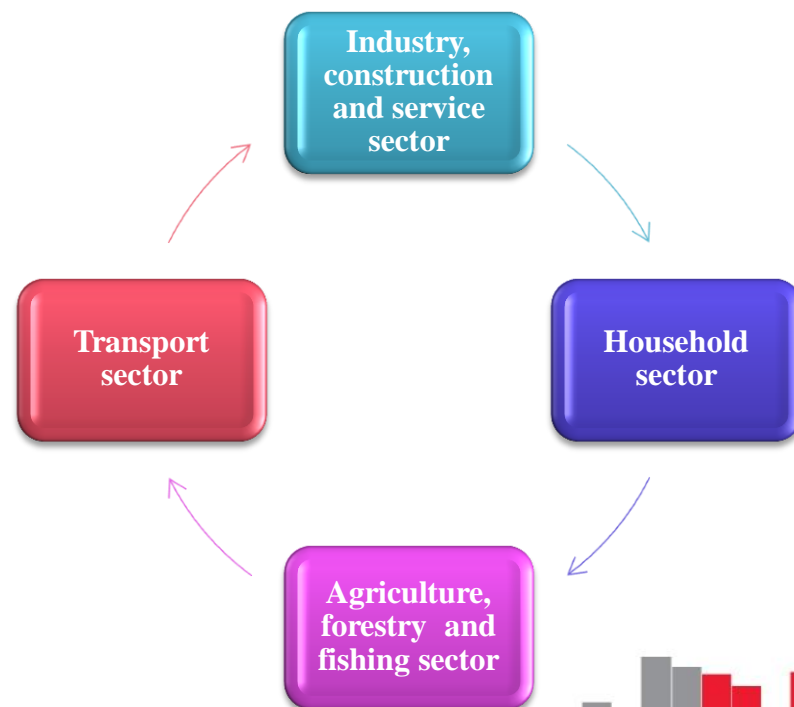

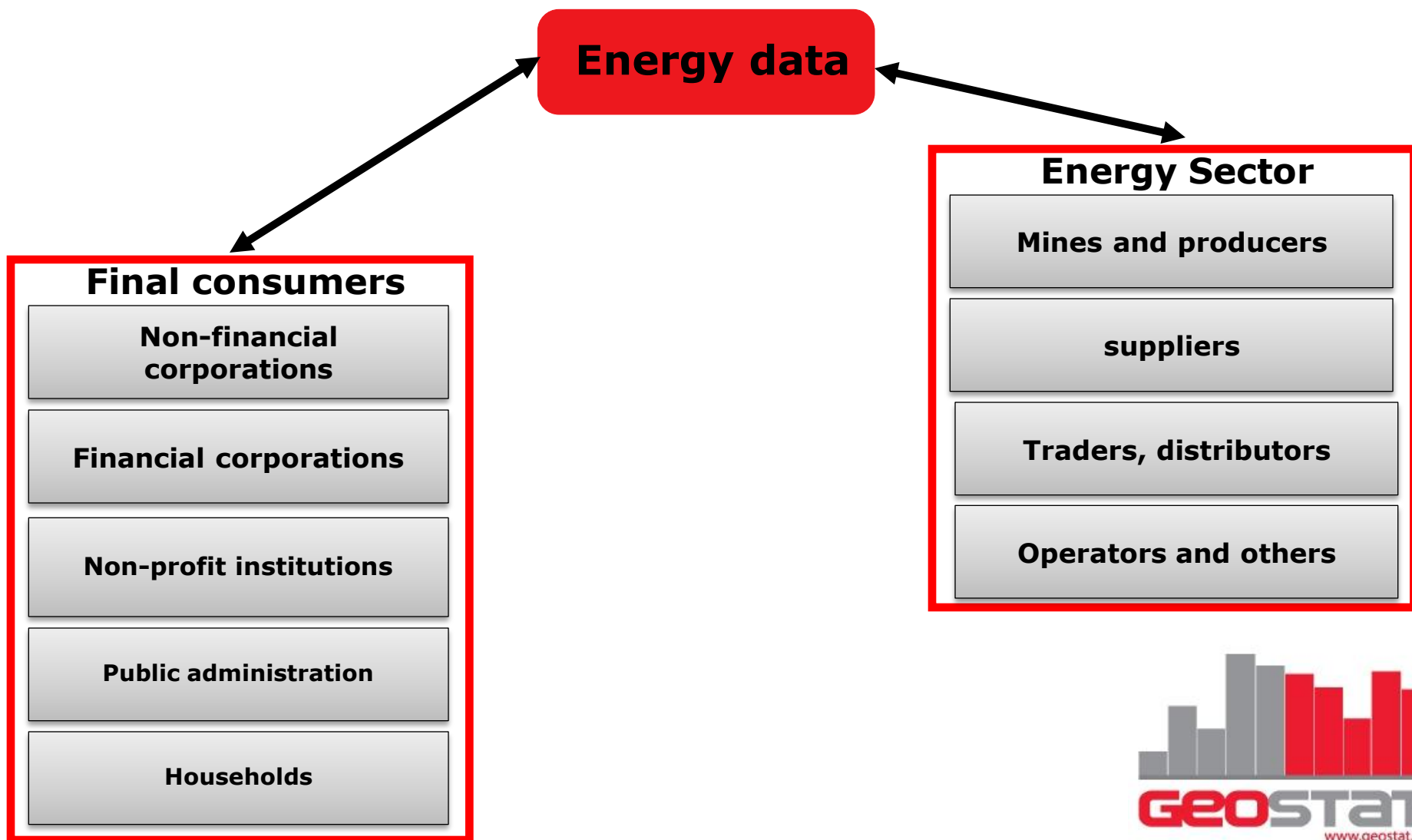

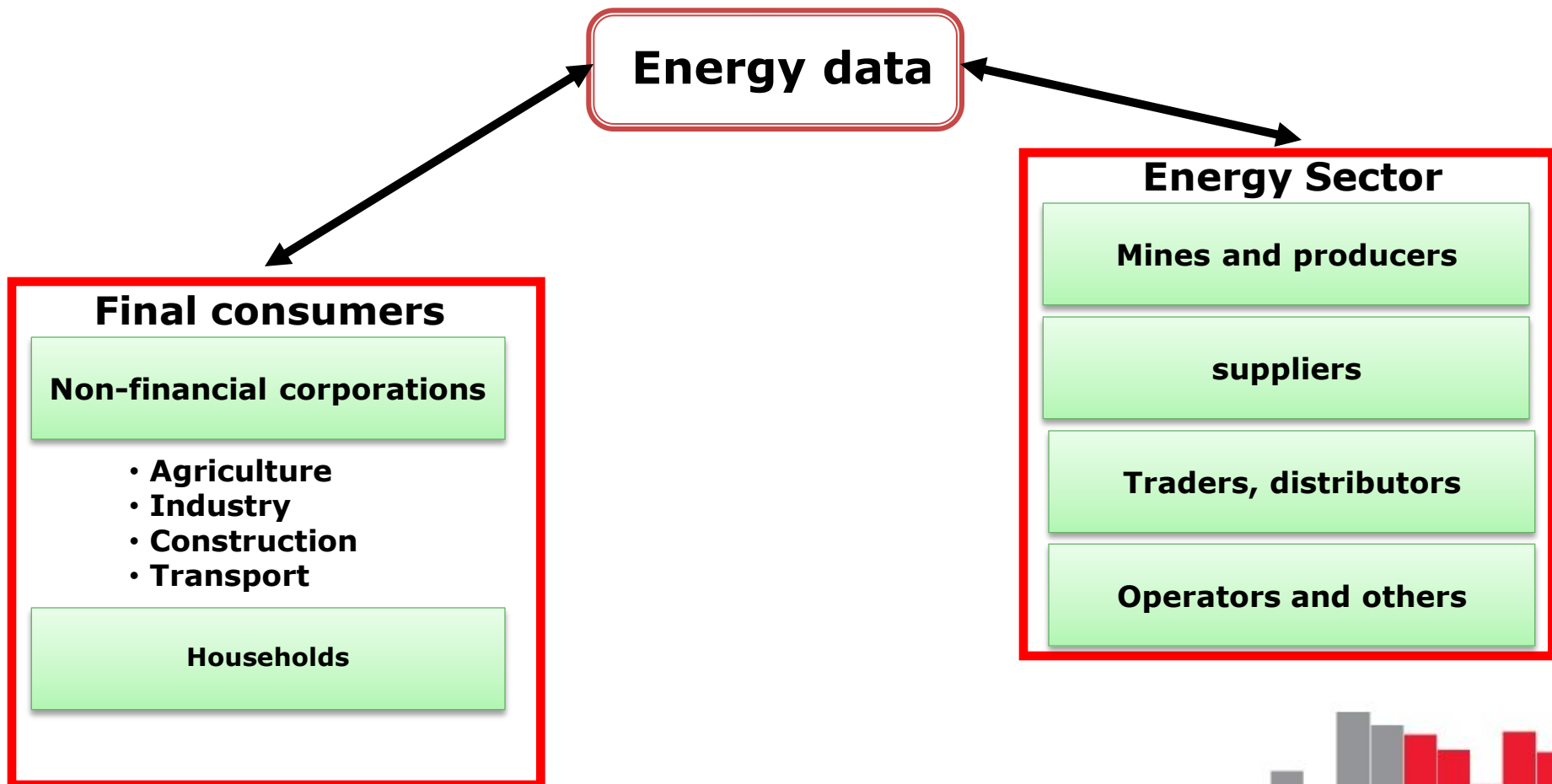

Data collection for 2013 Energy Balance



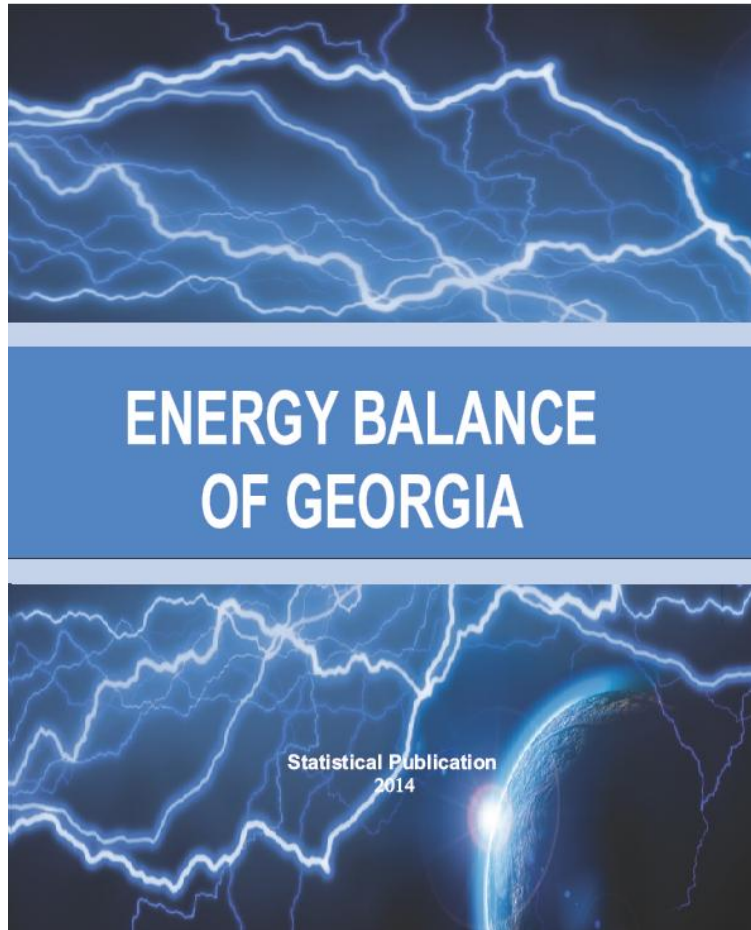
Data collection for 2014 Energy Balance



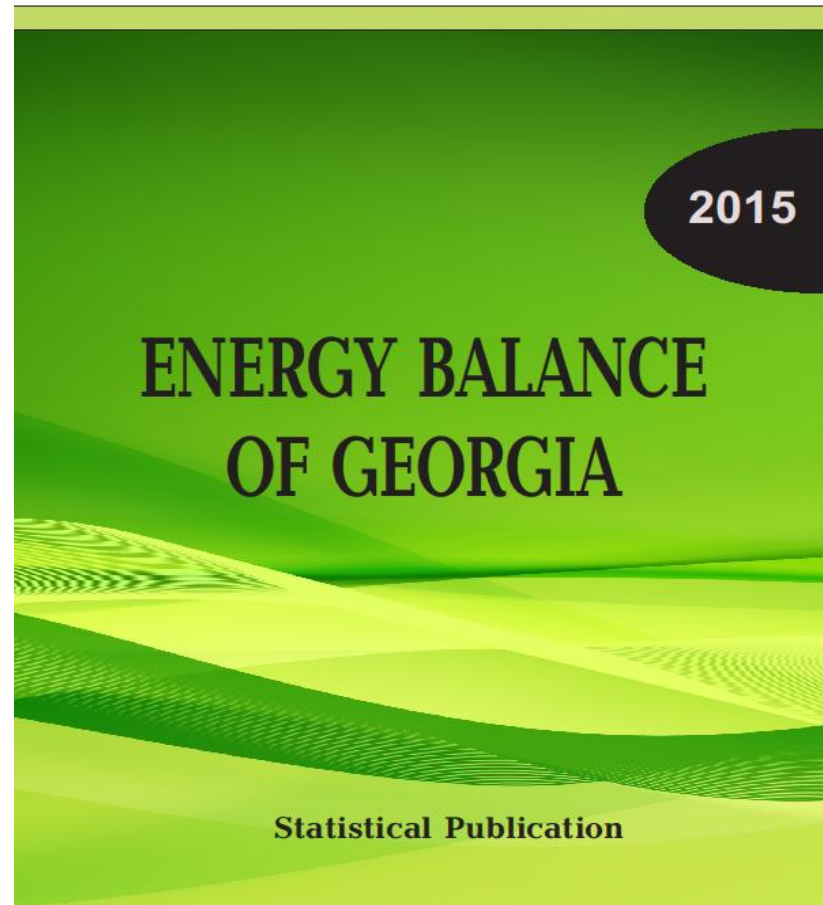
Energy Balance of GEORGIA

Improvements and differences

in comparison to the compilation of the 2013 energy balance

- Changes in the Law on Official Statistics of Georgia;
- Improved and updated sampling frame;
- Increased knowledge of staff (interviewers, supervisors, operators, analytical staff);
- More active cooperation and communication with producers, providers and users of energy statistics data;
- Improved system for data collection and more detailed output tables;
- Starting activities related production of monthly statistics (gas, oil);
- Use more and more administrative data for production of energy statistics.
