INOGATE Technical Secretariat (ITS)



- Budget: € 16.5 million
- Duration: 36 months (02.2012 – 01.2015)
- Partner Countries:
 - **Eastern Europe** - Belarus, Moldova, Ukraine,
 - **South Caucasus** - Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia
 - **Central Asia** - Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan (**separate INOGATE project in the field of SE**)
