Main and specific objectives

The main objectives of this three day capacity building seminar were:

- To teach sound business practice using life cycle cost analysis in development of EE/RES projects;
- To teach how to optimize energy conservation measures (ECMs) for maximum benefit and avoid life cycle losses;
- To teach realistic analysis, free of hypothetical input, through rigorous reality checks.

Out of 43 invited participants 34 took part in the training all three days. Training materials inclusive of exercises were provided in soft copy before the start of the seminar. A train-the-trainers session was conducted the last afternoon of the seminar.

Results achieved

A survey at the conclusion of the seminar showed very high satisfaction (average of about 95%) and a strong interest in both receiving additional training and in dissemination of lessons learned. Certificates were awarded to the participants who completed the training.
