Main and specific objectives

The **main objectives** of this assignment were to assist in the improvement of the regulatory and legal framework of energy management in Ukraine and provide capacity building to the beneficiaries on the application of EU energy management and standards.

The **specific objectives** of the project were (1) to review legislation in Ukraine relevant to energy management and compare discrepancies with the EU Standard EN 16001:2009 "Energy Management Systems - Requirements with guidance for use" (2) provision of recommendations on the adoption of the EN:16001:2009 standard in Ukraine (3) transfer of knowledge on international experience and best practices in energy management standards through capacity building to the staff of the Beneficiaries on effective design and elaboration of the standards and methodologies.

Results achieved

Between the time of application and implementation of UA.60 ISO 50001 was adopted to replace EN 16001, so SEMISE worked with ISO 50001. Beneficiaries such as municipalities, agencies and companies did, indeed, receive instruction on how to adopt the standard via a SEMISE seminar and report. Reaction by participants was very positive. They were hungry for this information, and some asked for more SEMISE technical assistance.
