Capacity Building: Industry Energy Audit Analysis for Bankable Projects

Main and specific objectives

The **main** objectives of this capacity building assignment were (1) To teach sound business practice using life cycle cost analysis in development of EE/RES projects (2) To teach how to optimize energy conservation measures (ECMs) for maximum benefit and avoid life cycle losses and (3) To teach realistic analysis, free of hypothetical input, through rigorous reality checks.

The **specific** objectives of these seminars were to train and empower participants who are senior engineers with decision making responsibilities and to impart practical skills through workshop exercises.

Results achieved

40 participants were invited and 38 attended of which 36 stayed for the train-the-trainer session. 78% of the participants answered a questionnaire stating that the seminar had been useful, and 71% stated that EU experiences were useful in Kyrgyzstan. The same number confirmed that they would apply their new knowledge in the jobs in the future. Satisfaction with the quality of instruction was 95%. This was the 6th presentation of this seminar in the Partner Countries, and participation in Bishkek set a record, exceeding expectations. The group also contained bankers and accountants, who need to learn the same analysis methodology as engineers.
