Main and specific objectives

The main objectives of this capacity building project (three day training course) were:

- To teach sound business practice using life cycle cost analysis in development of Energy Efficiency/Renewable energy projects;
- To teach how to optimize energy conservation measures (ECMs) for maximum benefit and avoid life cycle losses;
- To teach realistic analysis, free of hypothetical input, through rigorous reality checks.

The specific objective was to reach out to Teachers from institutions capable of delivering training themselves (educational institutions, associations, chambers, consulting companies) who can afterwards work as trainers.

Results achieved

22 trainees participated in the three day course and received certificates. 15 out of the 22 participants took part in the train-the-trainer session the last day. The impact of the training was evaluated by means of a 10 point quiz the last day. The general consensus was a desire for more training.
