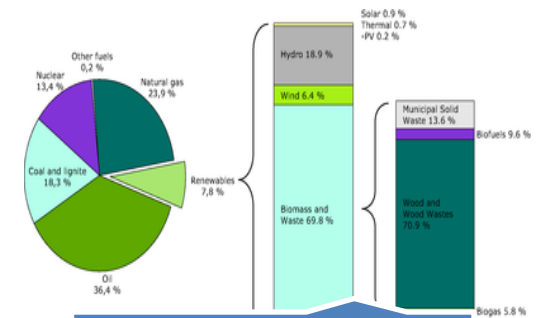

- Component A

 - Strengthen energy institutional governance in relation to sustainable energy, in particular by focussing on institutional capacity
- Component D
 - Enhanced use and harmonisation of energy statistics in line with European standards

Component C, Sustainable Energy



- Results to be achieved:
 - Improved capacity to implement and evaluate effective sustainable energy policies and action plans
 - Networks to enhance the exchange of experiences and best practices on policies and regulatory frameworks
 - Improvement in knowledge transfer as well as capacity building in the field of SE technologies

Component C, Sustainable Energy



- Outputs:
 - Support to primary and secondary legislation enabling a favourable investment climate for RE and EE (AHEF tasks)
 - Awareness raising assistance on the need for and benefits of increased energy efficiency & renewable energy use
 - Institutional framework for sustainable energy
 - Support to the monitoring of the Status Report (Baku Initiative Monitoring Framework)

Component C, Sustainable Energy



- Activities:
 - Facilitating development of national investment goals for SE
 - Facilitate investment in SE – improved legal frameworks, awareness raising, capacity building and technical assistance
 - AHEF tasks
 - Awareness raising
 - building demand among policy makers
 - raising awareness among wider public

Component C, Sustainable Energy



- Activities (continued):
 - Capacity building
 - Training Needs Assessment (TNA)
 - Study tours followed by workshops
 - Proposed thematic focus of study tours and workshops: bio-energy, SE financing, SE awareness, SE legislation, strategy and policy, best practices in SE, national SE programs etc
 - First study tour: bio-energy, October 2012, Slovakia
