# Main general figures

- ☞ The current feed-in tariff scheme of support entered into force on 22.04.2009
- ☞ As a result of 2010 the installed power capacity of solar plants was – 0 kW
- ☞ In 2011 the largest solar power plant in Europe (105 mW was commissioned – “Perovo”)
- ☞ As of 1.11.2012 the installed power capacity of solar power plants is about 250-270 mW)
- ☞ As of the end of November
  - ☞ 27 companies operated solar power plants (SPPs)
  - ☞ they operate 30 SPPs



# Legislation changes

- Law of Ukraine No. 601-VI of 25.09.2008 (the initial version of GT scheme of support does not work because of lack of guarantees and incentives)
- Law of Ukraine No. 1220-VI of 1.04.2009 (introduced the current scheme of support)
- Law of Ukraine No. 2799-VI of 17.12.2010, Law of Ukraine No. 3549-VI of 17.06.2011, Law of Ukraine No. 4065-VI of 18.11.2011, Law of Ukraine No. 3486-VI of 03.06.2011 (adjustments on LCR and state guarantee)
- Law of Ukraine No. 5485-VI of 20.11.2012 (the changes expected in 1.04.2012 to be discussed today)



# Future plans

## Macquarie Research

- ▢ till 2016 - more than 1,8 gW will be commissioned
- ▢ 2013 – 400 mW will be commissioned
- ▢ 2014-2015 – 500 mW will be commissioned each year

## Ministry of Fuel and Energy in renewed Energy Strategy till 2030:

- ▢ 1,5 -2,5 gW of commissioned solar plants capacity
- ▢ Electricity production 2 – 3,3 tW/h
- ▢ 2024 – by 30%
