

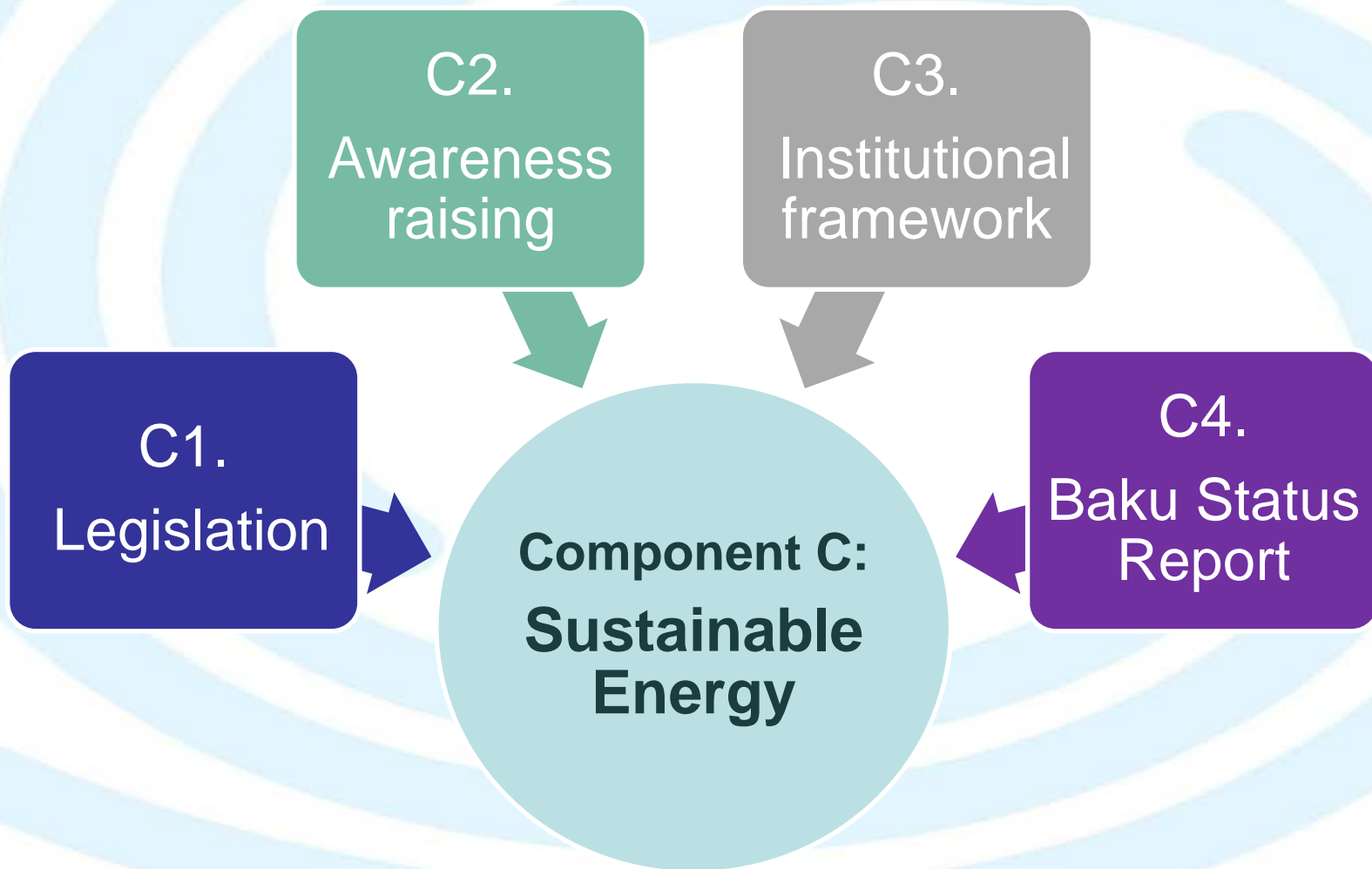

# Real Progress

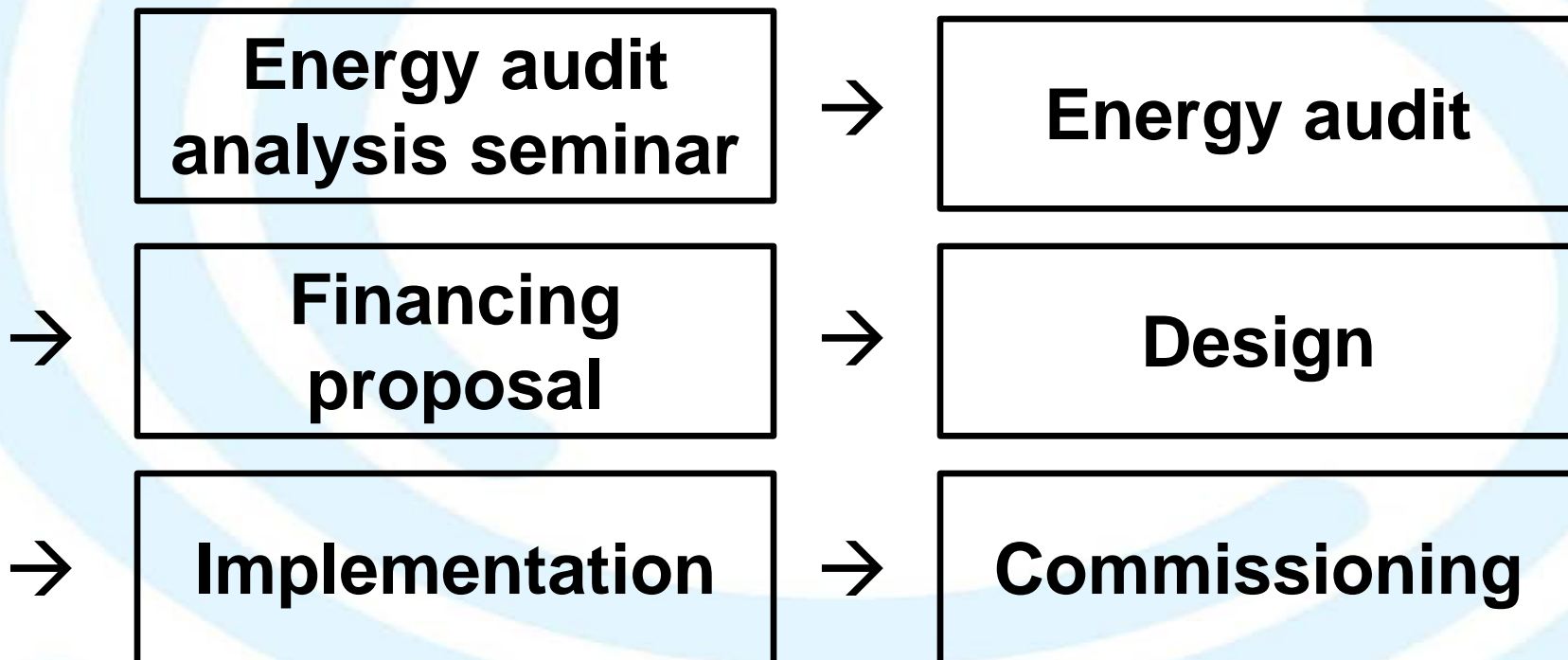
- ▶ Only with government commitment to move forward
