## **Second Energy Policy Talk on Future Governance of Energy Efficiency**

**On the 3rd of February at 15:00 the second Energy Policy Talks will take place in "Hotel Ukraina". Members of the Ukrainian government and Verkhovna Rada will join leading energy experts from around the European Union to look at governance solutions for supporting future energy efficiency in Ukraine. This is the second in the series of "Energy Policy Talks" aimed at developing the market reforms in Ukraine and sustainability.**
