Dear Mr. Nikolaos Tsakalidis,

The Ministry of Energy and Industry of the Kyrgyz Republic thanks you for the technical assistance on capacity building of the specialists in compilation and analysis of the fuel-energy balance of the Kyrgyz Republic (AHEF 113.KG).

To fulfill the technical assistance approved by the EU the ITS expert conducted 3 training seminars on capacity building of the representatives of the Ministry of Energy and Industry, the Regulator and enterprises of the fuel-energy complex in forecasting energy demand (electrical and heat energy, natural gas, etc.).

To prepare the final report on the implementation of the above mentioned TA, the Ministry prepared the baseline data for forecasting short-term, mid-term and long-term energy demand. The report prepared by the ITS experts, consists of 7 chapters, 2 annexes and has 39 figures and 52 tables. The report provides the required information on the key provisions, introduction, statistical database for forecasting short-term, mid-term and long-term energy demand (ambient temperature, GDP, natural gas, electrical and heat energy, population and final energy consumption). Based on the information prepared and the report, there is a forecast of electricity and heat energy demand up to 2017 and final energy consumption and measures for different industries (manufacturing, agriculture, transport, households and others) for long-term period from 2014 to 2035.

In connection with the above mentioned, the Ministry of Energy and Industry thanks the experts for the development of the report on compilation, analysis and forecast of the fuel and energy balance in the short-term, mid-term and long-term perspective.

In parallel the Ministry of Energy and Industry informs that in line with the instruction by the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic the Ministry has been developing a Draft Strategy of Energy Development up to 2035 and plans to use the information in the final report on analysis and forecasting the fuel and energy balance.

The Ministry would like to thank you again for the technical assistance being rendered to the Ministry of Energy and Industry and looks forward to further cooperation with the INOGATE Programme.
